

## ***Tiffany Circle*** - An International Network of Women Engaged in Humanitarian Projects

The Tiffany Circle, acting on behalf of the Red Cross, is a network of women who have come together over the years to support national and international humanitarian projects.

To initiate and sustain this wonderful initiative, we have had the support of two founding members, Mrs. Dania Samawi and Mrs. Dominique Brustlein-Bobst, without whom this circle could not have come to fruition.

***Project in Syria: Support for Women-Headed Households:*** In response to humanitarian challenges and urgent needs in Syria, the philanthropic program Tiffany Circle Switzerland is committed to supporting around a hundred women-headed households in the rural region of Deir Ezzor. The project aims to provide essential resources to help these women rebuild their livelihoods and revitalize their economic contribution, particularly in the dairy production sector, within their local communities.

**Area of Intervention:** The beneficiaries of the project are located in the eastern region of the Deir Ezzor Governorate in Syria, an area that has been affected by conflicts and economic disruptions.

**Concrete Action:** Within this project, 100 women receive direct financial assistance (an amount of 3,604,000 Syrian pounds, equivalent to about 740 Swiss francs) to reactivate their dairy production activities. This initiative aims to revitalize a key sector of the local economy while enhancing the economic resilience of women-headed households.

**Expected Impact:** The project has a dual impact: on one hand, it enables women to regain their economic independence and active role in society; on the other hand, it stimulates local dairy production, thereby contributing to improved food security and the local economy.

**Project in Switzerland** : On a Swiss scale, our project involves developing legal support to help migrants reunite with family members from whom they may have been separated during their migration.

In situations of war, forced exile, migration, or family conflicts, family members can be separated for various reasons. In such circumstances, the Swiss Red Cross's Tracing Service plays a crucial role by accompanying and supporting individuals in their quest to reunite with their loved ones.

**Critical Financial Support:** The financial support from the Tiffany Circle is of paramount importance. It not only enables our users to exercise their right to know the fate of their loved ones but also plays a vital role in continuing our efforts to raise awareness among law enforcement agencies and provide support in interactions with authorities.

**Conclusion:** The Family Reunification project, led by the Swiss Red Cross's Tracing Service with the support of the Tiffany Circle, stands as a crucial pillar in aiding families to reconnect in times of tragic separation.
